Yarn weigh	#3 (light/DK)
Fiber	100 % acrylic
Hook size	Susan bates 3.75 mm (F)
Sample size	66 Rs of the pattern, plus a 12 round border of bpdcc and dc (80 Rs total), hexagon. 50in/127cm side to side 56in/142cm point to point
Amount of yarn used for sample	Lion Brand Cupcake: 2 skeins = 1180 yds (1079 m), 300 g Bernat Baby Sport: 1.5 skeins = 1900 yds (1740 m), 530 g


